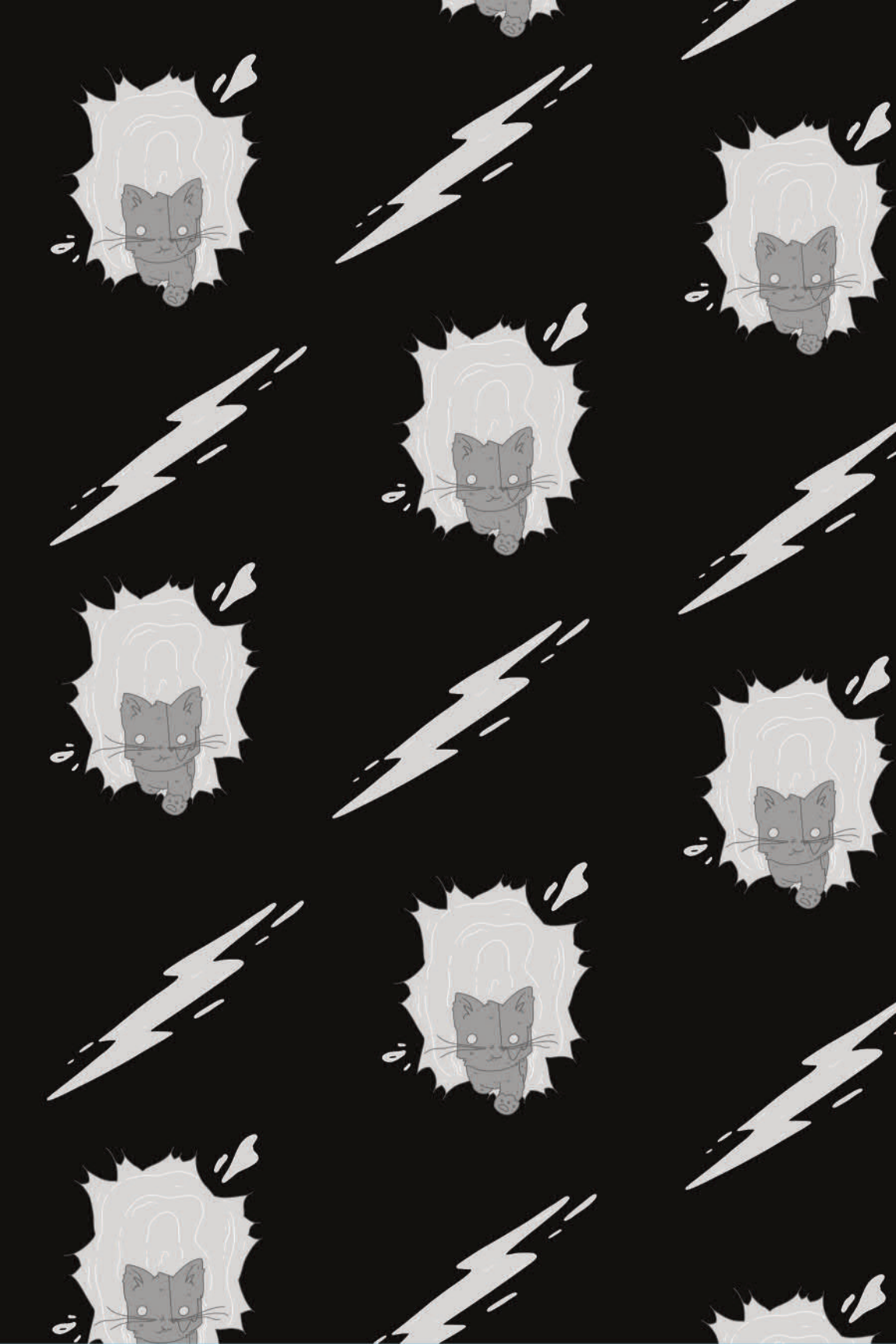

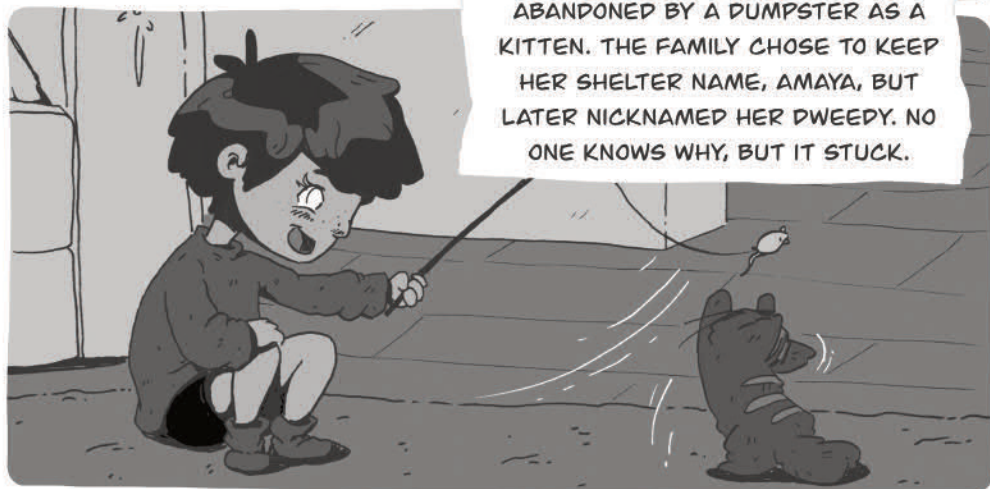

FICTITIOUS, THE CAT THEY'RE BASED ON WAS NOT.


